

## Eligibility Conditions

Eligibility conditions for admission to various B.E./B.Tech./B.Arch./Integrated B.E.(Chemical)-MBA courses at the participating institutes given in Chapter 1, are as detailed below:

### Academic Qualifications

The academic qualifications as prescribed in Information Bulletin and Application Form of JEE (Main)-2017 [Sections 2.9.2, 2.9.3, 3.1 and 3.2, JEE (Main)-2017, Information Bulletin] are applicable for this allocation/allotment, extract of which is reproduced below.

“Only those candidates who have passed their Class 12th Exam or any equivalent qualifying examination in 2015 or 2016; or those who are appearing in their Class 12th Exam or any equivalent qualifying examination in 2017 are eligible to appear in JEE (Main)-2017. **Candidates who passed Class 12th/Qualifying examination in 2014 or before as well as those who will appear in such examination in 2018 or later are not eligible to appear in JEE (Main)-2017. Candidates who appeared in Class 12th/equivalent qualifying examinations in 2014, did not pass in 2014, but passed in 2015 are also not eligible to appear in JEE (Main)-2017.**”

“Candidates must have taken at least five subjects in Class 12th/qualifying examination in order to be eligible for writing JEE (Main)-2017. The candidates who have taken four subjects are not permitted to write JEE (Main)-2017 and if such candidates appear in JEE (Main) - 2017 by furnishing wrong information, their rank/result will not be declared.”

Subject combinations required in the qualifying examination for admission to B.E./B.Tech./B.Arch./Integrated B.E.(Chemical)-MBA courses under JAC-2017 shall be as under:

Course	Required Eligibility Criteria based on Class 12th/Equivalent qualifying examination
B.E./B.Tech/ Integrated B.E. (Chemical)- MBA	1. Language 2. Physics 3. Mathematics 4. Any one of Chemistry/Biology/Biotechnology/Technical Vocational Subject 5. Any other subject. Only those candidates are eligible who have passed class 12th with at least 60% marks in aggregate (55% in case of candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe/Persons with Disability (PwD)/Backward Class) in the above subjects taken together.
B. Architecture	Only those candidates are eligible who have passed 10+2 scheme of Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent with Mathematics as subject of examination at the 10+2 level along with at least 50% marks in aggregate.

**Important points regarding the eligibility conditions followed by JAC-2017 are:**

1. All India Rank prepared by the CBSE on the basis of score in JEE (Main)-2017 shall be used for admission to B.E./B.Tech./B.E.(Chemical)-MBA by JAC-2017.
2. For admission to B.Arch., All India Rank prepared by the CBSE on the basis of score in JEE (Main)-2017, Paper -2 (B.Architecture/B.Planning) shall be used.
3. A candidate belonging to SC/ST/PwD/BC category shall be considered for seat allocation under General Category if he/she fulfills the eligibility conditions under General Category (i.e. at least 60% marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination). However, for other reserved categories (except General Category), such a candidate belonging to SC/ST/PwD/BC category shall be considered for seat allocation with relaxed eligibility criteria (i.e. at least 55% marks in aggregate in the qualifying examination).
4. A candidate who gets a compartment in the 12th examination held in March/April 2017 will not be eligible for admission under JAC-2017 even if he/she clears the same (by appearing in the supplementary examination) before the reporting /counselling dates.
5. **Aggregate marks percentage in 12th or equivalent examination shall be worked out as suggested by the certificate awarding Board/University/Council.** If the Board/University/Council awards letter grades without providing the equivalent percentage of marks on the grade sheet, the candidate should obtain a certificate from the respective Board/University/Council specifying equivalent percentage conversion formula and submit at the time of reporting/counselling. **In the absence of such a certificate, the decision of JAC-2017 regarding his/her eligibility shall be final.**

**General Conditions**

For admission to the B.E./B.Tech./B.Arch./Integrated B.E.(Chemical)-MBA courses, each candidate must

- (a) bear a good moral character and should not have been debarred from any institution/university,
- (b) be an Indian National (except for those seats which are open to NRIs),
- (c) satisfy the prescribed medical standards of fitness as follows-
  - i. Standard of Physique

A candidate must be in good mental and body health, and free from any physical defect likely to interfere with effective performance of duties of his/her profession.

- ii. Standard of Visual acuity with or without glasses should be:

Better Eye :	6/6 or 6/9	0/6
Worse Eye :	6/9 or 6/12	0/8

The total amount of myopia including the cylinder shall not exceed - 600 D

The total amount of hypermetropia including the cylinder shall not exceed +600 D.

**Inter-se Merit for Admission**

The inter-se merit of the candidates for admission will be determined on the basis of All India Rank (AIR) obtained in **JEE (Main)-2017** only, except in the **Sports Category** and the **Defence Category**. For complete information, kindly refer to Chapter 5 and Chapter 6.
