

Frequently Asked Questions

Q1. Which institutes are covered under JAC-2018?

1. University Institute of Engineering and Technology, Panjab University, Chandigarh
2. Dr. S.S. Bhatnagar University Institute of Chemical Engineering and Technology, Panjab University, Chandigarh
(Formerly Department of Chemical Engineering & Technology)
3. University Institute of Engineering and Technology, Panjab University SSG Regional Centre, Hoshiarpur
4. Chandigarh College of Engineering and Technology, Sector 26, Chandigarh
5. Chandigarh College of Architecture, Sector 12, Chandigarh

Q2. Which streams are available under JAC institutes?

Q3. I did not opt for Mathematics subject in 12th class. Am I eligible to apply for admission to various courses under JAC-2018?

No. A candidate must have studied Physics and Mathematics for admission to B.E. courses, and Mathematics for admission to B.Arch. course, along with other subjects. Refer to subject combinations required in the qualifying examination for admission to various courses under JAC-2018 on Page Nos. 8 and 9 of the JAC Information Brochure – 2018.

Q4. I belong to General Category and have secured 59.9% marks in 10+2 class. Am I eligible to apply for admission to various courses under JAC-2018?

No. For a General category aspirant, at least 60% marks in aggregate are required for admission to B.E. courses, and 50% marks in aggregate are required for admission to B.Arch. course. No rounding off in aggregate marks is allowed for determining the eligibility of a candidate. Refer to detailed eligibility criteria on Page Nos. 8 and 9 of the JAC Information Brochure-2018.

Q5. Do I need to apply separately for admission even after appearing in JEE (Main)-2018?

Yes. The candidate will be considered for admission to the five participating institutes under JAC-2018 only if he/she registers online before 30th June, 2018 by paying a registration /counselling fee as mentioned in the brochure.

Q6. Do I need to apply separately for each institution mentioned on your website?

No. After registering in JAC-2018, you may get admission in any of the five institutes depending upon your choice and JEE-Main (2018) rank.

Q7. Can a single application be made for multiple categories?

Yes. every candidate has to register only once to apply corresponding to all categories in which one wants to avail reservation.

Q8. What is the counselling schedule?

Please refer to Chapter 10 (Page nos. 122-124) of JAC Information Brochure – 2018.

Q9. Do I need to register myself separately for all rounds of counselling?

No, you are required to register only once and the registration by candidates is allowed only before the 1st round of counselling as per schedule given on Page no. 3 of JAC Information Brochure – 2018.

Q10. Can I skip first online counselling and register after it?

No, you cannot. No fresh registrations will be allowed after the last date of registration as per schedule given on Page no. 3 of JAC Information Brochure – 2018.

Q11. What would I do if I forgot my password?

If a candidate forgets his/her password, the additional information provided by the candidate at the time of registration will be used to get the new password. Hence, every candidate has to enter the required additional information as indicated in the registration form at the time of registration.

A candidate can change his/her password after login, if desired.

Q12. Do I need to apply separately for Engineering and Architecture courses?

A candidate applying for both Engineering and Architecture courses should register only once and choose course applying for as **Both**.

Q13. Do I need to send any confirmation slip to JAC, Chandigarh?

No, you need not.

Q14. Can I skip the physical verification of documents from 4th-6th July 2018?

No, you cannot skip. It is mandatory for the candidates desirous of seeking admission under reserved categories (except SC, ST) to get their documents verified in order to be eligible for participating in online counselling under that category. Candidates who do not appear for document verification will not be considered for admission in the reserved categories, however they will be considered for admission under General Category, provided they are eligible. The sports category candidates desirous of seeking admission in participating institutes of Panjab University (UIET, Chandigarh; Dr. SSB UICET and UIET PUSSGRC, Hoshiarpur) have to appear for Sports Gradation on 3rd and 4th of July, 2018 as per schedule given in Page nos. of 122-124 of JAC Information Brochure – 2018.

Q15. Is the counselling fee to be paid during all counselling rounds?

No. Counselling fee is to be paid only once at the time of registration.

Q16. If I am issued a certificate for seeking reservation after the closing date of application, will that certificate be entertained?

No, any certificate issued after 6th July 2018 will not be considered.

Q17. If I do not mention a particular category in my application at the time of registration, will I be considered for that on request at the time of counselling?

No, you will not be considered for that category. However, you can make corrections in your filled details including category information during the correction window which will be opened on 1st - 2nd July 2018.

Q18. Can I change my filled choices and their preference order?

Candidates are permitted, if they so desire, to change or re-order their choices, delete earlier choices and add new choices any number of times until they lock their final choices before final **locking date**.

After the choices are locked, candidates will not be able to change their choices. If a candidate does not lock his/her choices by the due date, his/her Last Saved Choices will automatically be locked after deadline.

Q19. If I take admission in first counselling and do not pay fees at the allotted institute, will I still be eligible for next counselling round?

No. However, you will be eligible for SPOT round of Counselling after depositing a SPOT round participation fee of Rs. 40,000/-.

Q20. If I take admission in one particular institute through Joint Admission Committee in first counselling and shift to some other institute in subsequent counselling, will the fees be adjusted?

Yes, the fee will be adjusted.

Q21. Do I need to physically report somewhere after first round of counselling or to pay fees?

Candidates are not required to go anywhere for Physical reporting after seat allotment. Payment of fee using any one of the mode and online submission of willingness for the subsequent rounds will be treated as reporting against allotted seat.

Q22. Can I change my choice after first round of counselling?

Yes, candidates can modify their choices after 1st round of counselling. Otherwise, choices submitted for 1st round will be considered for 2nd round of seat allotment. As per new choices, a new seat may be allotted or previous seat will be retained.

Q23. Do I need to physically report somewhere after third round of counselling?

All provisionally admitted candidates of (1st /2nd /3rd rounds) are required to physically report as per the counselling schedule Page Nos. 122-124 of JAC Information Brochure – 2018 for document verification.

Q24. What documents I need to bring at the time of physical verification?

The candidate should refer to **Chapter 7** of JAC Information Brochure – 2018, regarding the documents which he/she has to bring at the time of reporting/counselling.

Q25. Can I withdraw my allotted seat and seek refund?

Yes, a candidate, who takes provisional admission and wants to cancel his/her allotted seat can do so by following the withdrawal procedure mentioned in Page Nos. 27 and 28 of JAC Information Brochure – 2018. Further the refund rules are also mentioned in the Page No. 27. After reporting at the allotted institute, the refund rules will be applicable as per the norms of the allotted institute.

Q26. I belong to OBC category. Am I eligible for admissions in B.E?

There is no reservation for OBC category, hence you are not eligible under this category. However, your candidature can be considered under the general category as per category eligibility.

Q27. How much is the admission fee and when it has to be paid?

All the five institutes have different fee structures. Kindly refer to Chapter 5 and Chapter 6 of JAC Information Brochure – 2018 for details.

Q28. How will I get hostel?

The candidates, who want to avail hostel facilities, should contact the respective allotted institute/college on the day of physical reporting to apply for their seat in the hostel. It may not be possible to accommodate a candidate in the hostel, if he/she does not apply for the hostel seat on the same day and does not follow the prescribed procedure for the same. The hostel accommodation will be given as per rules and regulations of participating institutes.

Q29. What is the placement scenario of different streams in the five institutes?

Q30. What were the closing ranks in different streams in different institutes last year?
